NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE (CHARGES TO OVERSEAS **VISITORS) (SCOTLAND) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS** 2014 (SSI 2014/70): EXEMPTION FROM CHARGES FOR **ALL HIV TREATMENT** 

# **Purpose**

1. To advise NHSScotland of the above amendments to the NHS (Charges to Overseas Visitors) (Scotland) Regulations 1989 which came into force on 1st May 2014. amendments have implications for both primary and secondary NHS healthcare providers.

# Exempting for overseas visitors from charges for all HIV treatment

- 2. In 2012 the UK Government took the decision, on the strength of the House of Lords Report - No Vaccine, No Cure: HIV and AIDS in the United Kingdom, that it would amend the English NHS Charges to Overseas Visitors Regulations to exempt overseas visitors, including asylum seekers, from charges for all HIV treatment. Previously only testing and counselling was provided at no cost to overseas visitors.
- In Scotland, asylum seekers are already exempt from all charges for NHS treatment, regardless of the status of their application for asylum. There may however be a small cohort of other patients to whom charges could apply. In 2012 it was agreed by Scottish Ministers that all overseas visitors should be exempt from charges for HIV treatment in the interest of public health, and that this should be put on a legal footing when an appropriate opportunity arose.

Amendments to the National Health Service (Charges to Overseas Visitors) (Scotland) Regulations 1989 in advance of The XX Commonwealth Games (as outlined in CEL 08 (2014)) presented an opportunity to amend the law in respect of this. Regulation 3 and Schedule 1 of the Regulations have therefore been amended to exempt all HIV treatment from charges from 1<sup>st</sup> May 2014.
