GP Practice Workload & Sustainability

- The vast majority of practices are at level one of the escalation framework. There are four practices at level 2.
- There are ten practices with closed lists.
- The next iteration of the escalation framework is being finalised and will be taken to SEG for approval. The GP Subcommittee and LMC have been engaged with the board on this.
- SGPC has published practice workload guidance with steps that practices can take to reduce excessive workload ensure that services are safe and sustainable.
- The BMA Scotland vacancies survey shows that the vast majority of practices are working with demand exceeding capacity.
