



Update on sexual health screening in NHS GGC –11th December 2020

Action: *Please only request a sexual health screen (chlamydia and gonorrhoea test) in someone with symptoms or a confirmed high risk contact*

Information

The West of Scotland Specialist Virology Centre are currently under a lot of pressure due to COVID testing and the capacity for CT/GC tests is much reduced. As a consequence, Sandyford services are only offering testing to those with symptoms who are at risk of an STI (i.e. new sexual partner) or a high risk, recent and confirmed contact (i.e. a regular partner of someone with one of these infections). The WoSSVC would greatly appreciate if CT/GC testing in primary care could be limited to these indications also.

Unfortunately, we ask that for the time being, that testing is <u>not performed in asymptomatic</u> <u>individuals</u> who are not high risk.

Syndromic or presumptive management with antibiotics without testing for STIs should be avoided if at all possible – it is appropriate to test in those with symptoms.

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
