

Public holidays 2022

Following confirmation from Scottish Government of the additional public holiday for GP practices on 3 June 2022 to recognise the platinum jubilee, the public holiday dates for GP practices have been discussed and agreed with the Local Medical Committee

The 3 June holiday is in addition to the existing end May public holiday for practices. This will remain unchanged at the original date of 30 May. This takes account of the fact that there are different approaches across the different Local Authority areas, the need to provide Out of Hours cover on those days and the fact that directly managed NHS services will be continue to operate as usual on those days. It avoids creating an additional 4 day weekend which creates significant pressure across all services. The dates are set out below and include the fair holiday dates for GP practices. The GP Out of Hours service will provide cover on these dates as per usual public holiday arrangements.

Monday 30 May

Friday 3 June

Monday 4 July (Inverclyde)

Monday 18 July (Greater Glasgow and Clyde except Inverclyde and Renfrewshire)

Monday 1 August (Renfrewshire)
