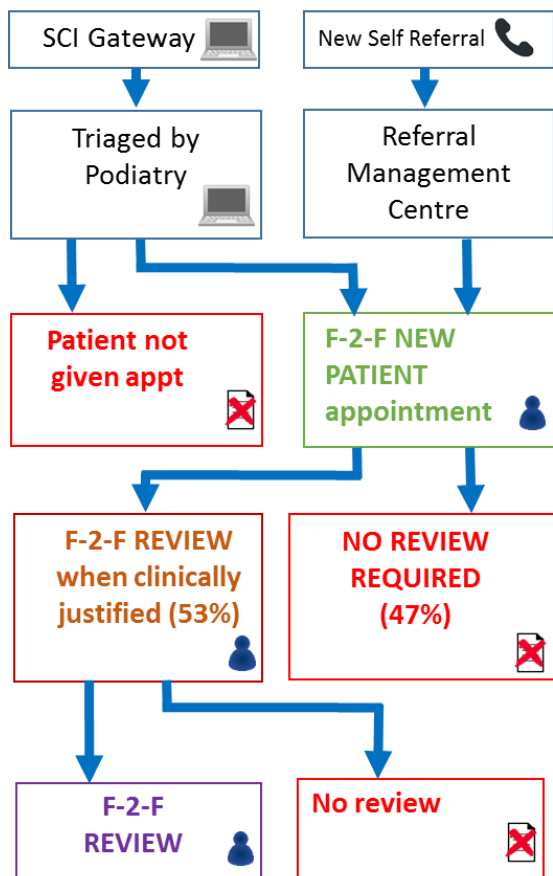


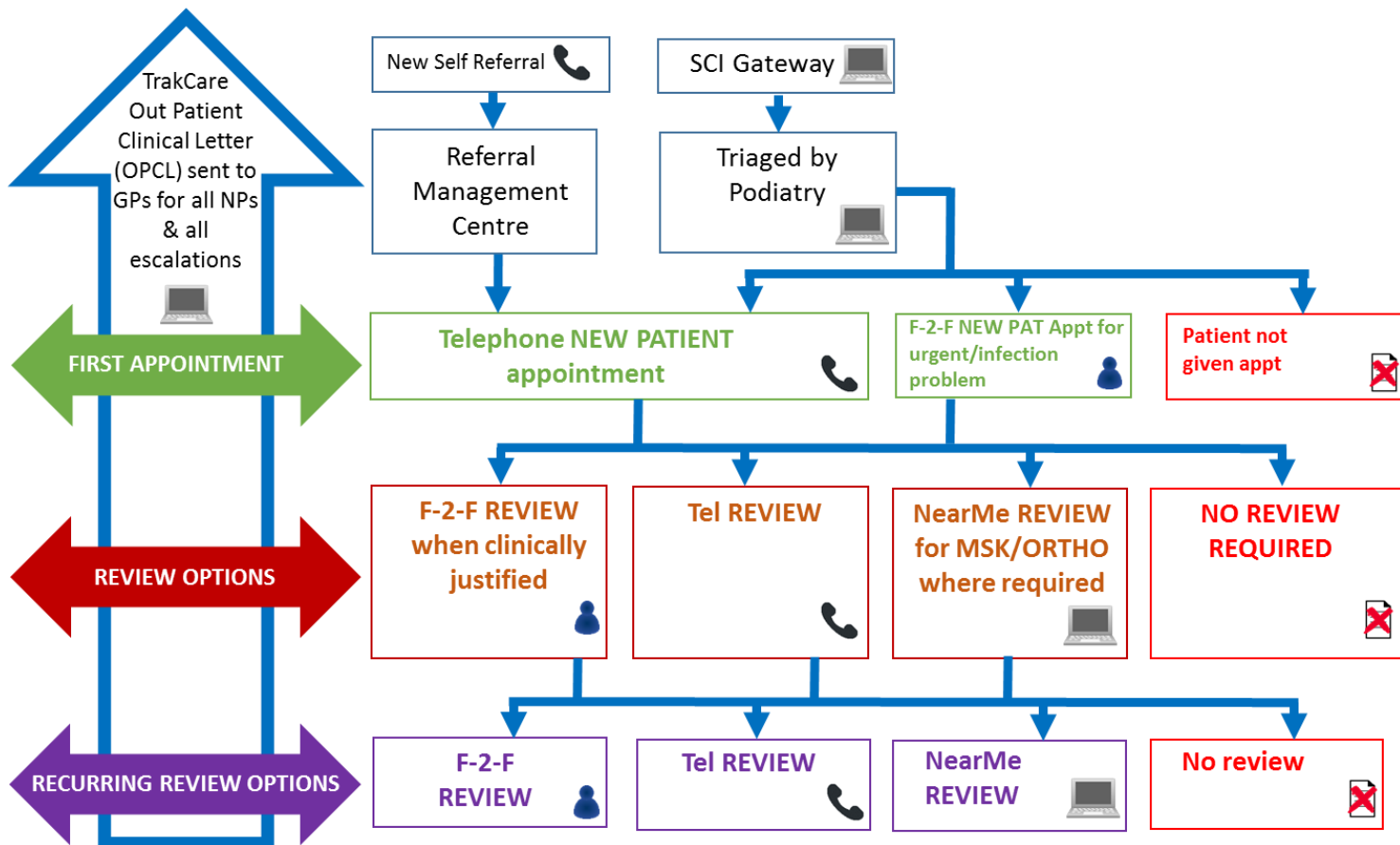
**NOTES:**

1. This timeline shows NHSGG&C Podiatry Service recovery plan milestones for the information of existing patients, GPs and other HCPs.
2. Patients will be sent appointments by the service inviting them to attend at the appropriate phase, based on the historic frequency of their foot health needs.
3. Those requiring urgent care for wounds or infections will be prioritised and seen within 2 working days of contact or referral to the service.

2. Urgent referrals for infections or wounds, or referrals for orthopaedic triage, should be sent via SCI Gateway or TrakCare.
3. No referrals will be returned (unless they are clinically inappropriate). Those requiring non-urgent care will be placed on the waiting list.
4. Those requiring urgent care for wounds or infections will be prioritised and seen within 2 working days of contact or referral to the service.
