To All GPs and GP Practices

We worked through the Easter and May public holidays to support the NHS. We stepped up to support the Covid Community Pathway. We helped the whole health system and patients with the ACP and Shielding work. We delivered the 18-64 flu programme. We are stepping up to offer Covid vaccinations to our older patients. All whilst dealing with practice workloads which are higher than pre-pandemic levels.

We can be proud of our collective response to the pandemic.

Take time to rest over the festive period. Stay safe. 2021 will undoubtedly throw further challenges to us but we know that GPs and practices will be resilient, and the LMC will be here to support you.

Covid Vaccination Programme

The Oxford-AstraZeneca Covid-19 vaccine is pending approval by the MHRA for use in the UK. As this vaccine is simpler than the Pfizer vaccine to distribute and store (normal fridge temperatures), the plan is that it will be used by GP practices for the over 80s Covid vaccination programme. The opt in letters for the Covid-19 Vaccination DES were sent to practices this week. An FAQ will be coming out once more information is known. This will cover issues around ordering of the vaccine, safe storage and use, guidance and education on the administration of the vaccine, and IT / data entry.

Covid-19 Staff Vaccinations

NHSGGC published the <u>staff groups who will be given initial priority</u> for the staff vaccination programme. GPs working in Red Zones - the CACs and GP OOHs and those in higher risk groups will be amongst the first to be immunised. Information has been sent to GP practices about the prioritisation and how GPs and staff members will be able to receive their immunisations.

Many GPs have been concerned about the prioritisation list and we have urgently raised those concerns with the Health Board. <u>A communication was sent to all practices</u> on Thursday about

the programme and the prioritisation process. We continue to have meetings with the Board and clinical leads about staff vaccinations, and our aim is that GPs and practice staff are vaccinated as soon as possible -adequate vaccine supplies allowing.

AWI and Care Home Residents

GPs are reminded that the 176 days extension period to Adults with Incapacity Section 47 certificates has expired. It is important that AWI certificates are up to date for care home residents who are due to receive the Covid-19 vaccinations. We ask that GPs prioritise this group of patients for any AWI update.

The <u>Mental Welfare Commission for Scotland has guidance</u> about AWI assessments by video or telephone. Section 4.6 of the document gives advice on assessments and examination by video or telephone. It is quite a lengthy section but the take home message for GPs especially with patients in care homes is that "*the use of technology for MHA assessments, rather than a second choice may actually be preferable*."
