To All GPs and GP Practices

These include changes to the immunisation programme, lateral flow testing, and self isolation guidance. There is also targeted deployment of new Covid-19 medicines in GGC.

General practices continue to operate under high workload and staffing pressures. We are extremely grateful for all our colleagues who will be supporting the Community Pathway, CACs, and GP Out of Hours over the festive period.

New Covid-19 Medicines

GGC has a Boardwide deployment for new nMAB and anti-virals effective against severe Covid-19 disease for non-hospitalised patients. The inclusion criteria for these medicines are-

- ullet SARS-CoV-2 infection is confirmed by PCR testing within the last 5 days
- AND
- Onset of symptoms of Covid-19 within the last 5 days

AND

They are a member of a "highest" risk group

Exclusion Criteria are-

- Patient requires hospitalisation for Covid-19
- New supplemental oxygen required specifically for management of Covid19 symptoms
- Weight <40kg for sotrovimab
- Children aged under 12 years (sotrovimab) or under 18 years (for molnupiravir)

New Self-Isolation Guidance

The Scottish Government has updated the guidance for self-isolation exemption and lateral flow testing for healthcare workers.

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The existing isolation policy for staff who are household or passing contacts of covid-19 positive cases, exempts them from the requirement to self-isolate for 10 days when they:

- are double-vaccinated;
- are asymptomatic and remain asymptomatic,
- undertake PCR test (which returns a negative test result before returning to work), and;
- undertake daily LFD testing for the remainder of the 10 day period.

An important addition to this is that staff must be

• double vaccinated and had their booster (with the booster vaccination at least 14 days from the last exposure to the case).

Daily Lateral Flow Testing for Healthcare Workers

In response to evidence that Omicron is more transmissible, all HCWs are now advised to increase testing from twice weekly to daily testing using the new Orient Gene 20 LFD test kits (OG20s).

Fit Notes

Temporarily, employees will not be required to provide their employer with medical evidence of sickness absence for the first 28 days of absence. GPs will still be required to supply fit notes for periods of absence exceeding 28 days. The Government guidance states-

"If an employee goes off sick on or after 10 December 2021, up to and including 26 January 2022, you cannot ask them for proof of sickness until they have been off for 28 days or more."
