To All GPs and GP Practices

July is fast approaching and we hope that GPs and practice staff can look forward to a well-deserved break over the summer. We know that workload and staff pressures remain at unsustainable levels in practices. Once again, we thank everyone working in GP practices for their continued hard work in delivering a safe and effective service to patients.

GP Practices Under Pressure

Dr John Ip wrote in the <u>Scotsman newspaper</u> this week about the "triple whammy" on GP practices- difficulty of service delivery with Covid restrictions in place, the rising number of patient contacts and demands, and the surge in unacceptable behaviour that practices are dealing with.

The Board has also released a <u>Youtube video</u> from Dr Kerri Neylon explaining to the public how GP practices are operating to provide safe care and to prioritise clinical need.

We hope that these messages will provide the public with some idea of the pressures that we are all under currently. We continue to work with Board and national groups to find solutions to help practices.

SGPC Snap GP Workload and Wellbeing Survey

The BMA Scottish GP Committee ran a short survey in mid-May to get an idea of the current pressures on GPs across Scotland. The key findings from the survey-

- 669 responses
- 2 out of 3 GPs describe workload as unmanageable
- 73% reporting negative impact on wellbeing
- 70% more likely to seek early retirement
- 87% of GP and practice staff have been subject to physical or verbal abuse from public within the last month

This information demonstrates the impact that demand is having on GPs and their staff, and allows SGPC to push for improvements to help improve the situation for GPs.

Covid Pathway for 0-4 year olds

The CAC referral pathway for 0-4 year olds was updated on 14th June 2021. The Covid pathway for the over 5s and adults remains unchanged.

The Board wrote to practices with information on the updated pathway-

International Travel

Practices are receiving requests from patients for letters to exempt them from quarantine following international travel. The rules on entering Scotland and quarantine requirements are set out here <u>Coronavirus (COVID-19)</u>: <u>international travel and managed isolation (quarantine)</u> <u>gov.scot (www.gov.scot)</u>. There is no role for GPs in this process.

Practice MDT Survey Reminder

In autumn 2019 SGPC conducted a survey of practices across Scotland to gauge the level of MDT support they were receiving with the implementation of the 2018 Contract. The survey is now being re-run to establish what progress has been made in the interim and how far from the perspective of individual practices we still have to go with implementation.

This is a <u>letter from Dr Andrew Buist Chair of SGPC</u> to practices asking them to participate in the survey.
